

Utility Costs

According to a State wide study the Holland and Zeeland Board of Public Works have the 2nd and 3rd lowest power costs in the State of Michigan for large industrial users. This can often provide a significant yearly savings to your bottom line. Often the results are 15-20% less than rates available elsewhere. Below are some example rates. The below numbers are estimates.

Electric:

Rates vary depending upon average usage. With a typical usage pattern of a large Industrial customer, they could expect to pay approximately \$0.0625 - \$0.065 per kWh.

Water:

Water rates vary by season, but are still among the lowest in the state.

\$0.78/100 cubic ft for Nov – April

\$0.94/100 cubic ft for May- Oct.

Fire Protection:

4 inch \$5.66 /mo

6 inch \$9.10/mo

8 inch \$19.86/mo

10 inch \$44.06/mo

12 inch \$71.40/mo

Wastewater:

Customers are billed according to the amount of water metered throughout the year.
